





Louise Mounsey, Our Treasurer, Patti Stefaniw was unable to attend...she was unexpectedly called out of town. We had 40 members attend our meeting today.

Annell, who is in charge of EGC Directory, gave us an update for our club directories. At the welcoming committee table today there were Avery Labels available for us with contact information for our member, Kristina Hughes, please put this information in your directories. Additionally she asked if anyone knew how to contact Jean Barta or Guinevere Larson; both are paid members but we don't have their EGC Information form . We want to get their names into the system so they can be contacted as needed. Also, please note the following changes: Margot Constable has taken the Historian/ Photographer position as one of our photographers who will join Susan Blake in taking pictures. Cherie Luke has taken over the EChO Table, and Cindy Gibson will continue taking care of the Welcoming table. Annell also gave us an update on the use of a vehicle for the Rodeo Parade. The board has decided that it would be great fun to have a 1965 vehicle that is the same year as The Evergreen Garden Club was established. Jo Powers will check on the year of the vehicle that her husband, Jon, owns. She will contact Annell, Paul, or Barbara, with that information. Additionally. Annell told us a quart of bulk wild flower seed mix will be purchased if it is absolutely necessary. We are hoping that members will donate enough of the seeds that they have collected and to please give them to Annell. Barbara Steger has purchased envelopes for the seeds...we have decided to have them professionally printed front and back as soon as the verbage for the Expo ad has been determined. We are in need of people who will help assemble the packets, additionally, parade walkers who are capable of walking two miles are needed to pass out flower seed packets. Walkers will wear EGC T-Shirts, (design to be determined) walking shoes or cowboy boots, blue jeans, plus cowboy hats. Annell sent around two different clip boards for these two items. Registration and payment for entry into the parade is due in March of 2015. Any questions or concerns please touch base with Annell. Additionally she reminded us of three important dates to remember in regard to our 50th anniversary year
