Happy New Year!

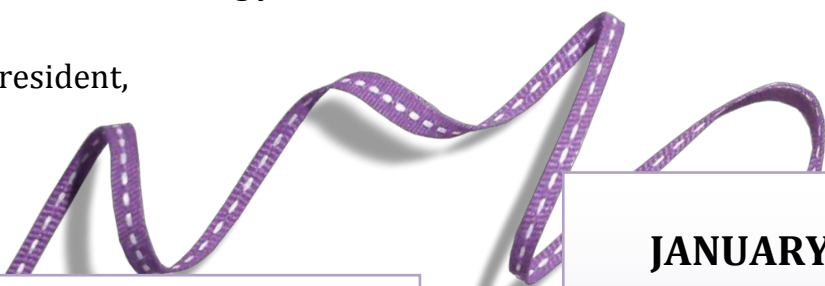

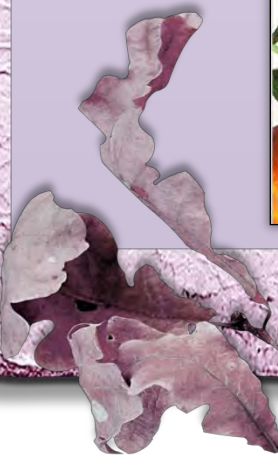
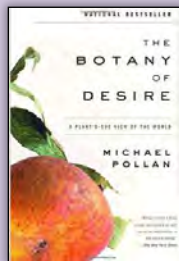


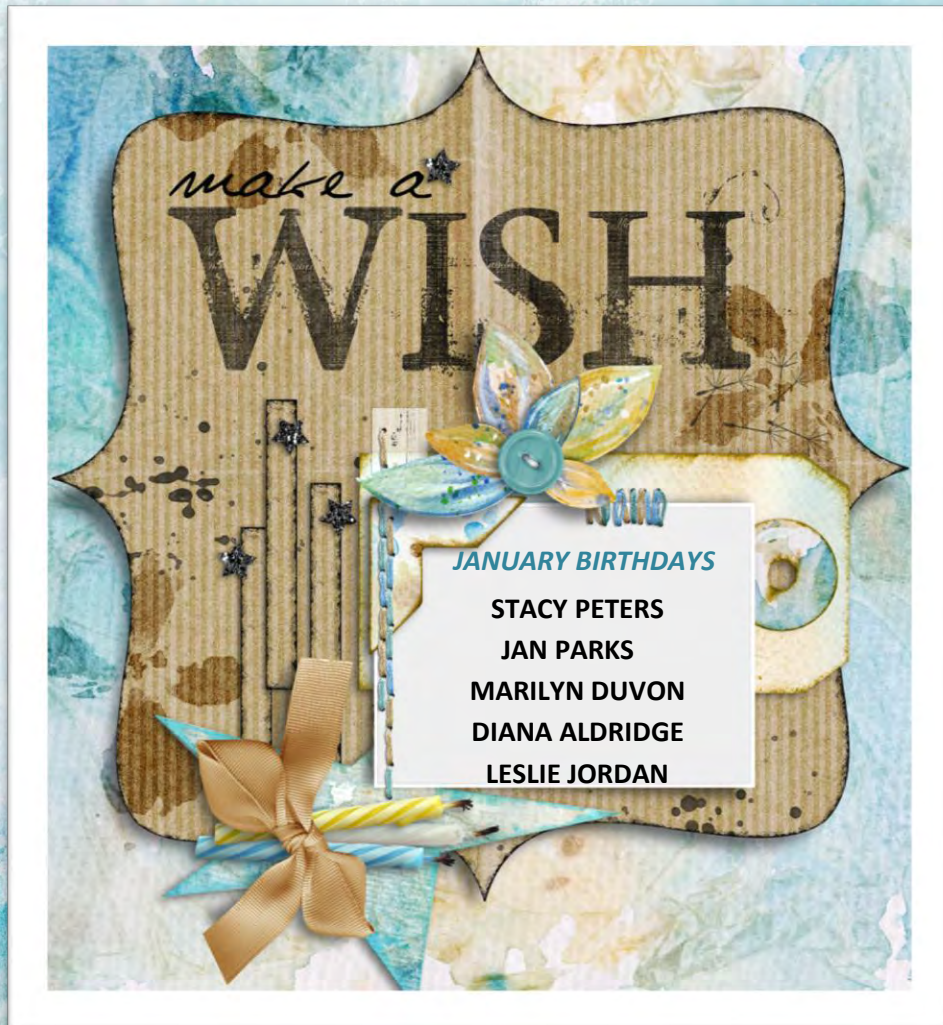
The Colorado Master Gardener Program – Jefferson County sends a hearty

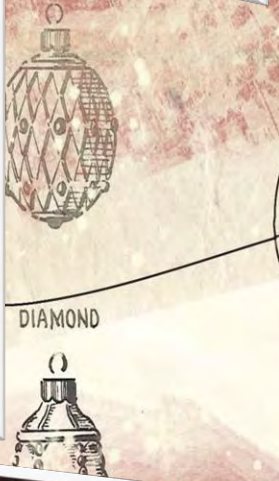
